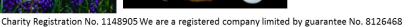

Community speed watch schemes enable groups of concerned residents to address speeding problems in their area. Speed watch groups monitor the speeds of passing vehicles using speed guns. They record and report the speed and identifying details of vehicles travelling at or above nationally-specified speed thresholds. Community speed watch is a partnership between the community, the police and the council.
