We're still finalising the works program with South Gloucestershire Council but we hope that it won't be long before we start.

As a reminder, we will be putting in staggered barriers between the top of Gilpin Close and the green to make it harder for motorcycles to get around where they shouldn't. And we are putting planters on to the road in Gilpin to provide visual pinch points to slow traffic. We are doing this because speeding has been raised as an issue in Gilpin.

Thanks to the group's efforts, Gilpin is still accepted as a policing priority to help deal with speeding and motorcycles on pavements and the green.
