Family Support Services

Family Wise

Family Wise is for families with one or more children aged between 8 and 12 years old. We need 2 or more of the following criteria to consider the referral:



Strong Communities Powered by People

A child who has had 10% absences (authorised and unauthorised) from school for an average across the last three consecutive terms. A child who has been identified as needing early help, including young carers.

An adult in receipt of out of work benefits or an adult who is claiming universal credit and subject to work related conditions. An adult with mental health issues and who has parenting responsibilities or a child with mental health issues where the child has been open to social care e.g. CIN or CP.

Adults or children who are referred by professionals as having any mental or physical health issues but the family are not open to social care.

Attendance concerns, not receiving full-time education OR education an identified concern.

What we do...

You will be assigned a family support worker that will contact you to make an initial visit.

We always begin the process with an initial visit, this will usually be done with your family at your home where we complete an assessment and make an action plan based on the needs and wishes of your family.

We work in partnership with the referrers and all other professionals that are involved with your family. We regularly attend SAF meetings to aid the flow of communication in order to provide the best possible service.

If appropriate we regularly meet with your children to ensure their voices are heard



and part of our plan of action. These meetings are done in a relaxed and friendly manner and usually at your child's school or in your child's home.

We can signpost your family to other agencies and services that we feel will benefit you further.
