



The Kingswood beat team were out and about engaging with the public, we were at the Jubilee Celebrations at Warmley Forest Park and in Kingswood Park – Wow! so many people, all in good spirits, all having a wonderful time.

I thought you might like to know a little about our team. The Kingswood Neighbourhood Policing team has 6 members and a Sergeant, We have 2PCs, Jack and Aaron and 4 PCSOs, Kay, Christian, Lauren and Adam, You will often see us somewhere on the Kingswood beat, Lauren and Adam often on cycles, The rest on foot or sometimes in a car. We are here to help so if you do have an issue you would like to discuss please don't hesitate to speak to us. We can also be contacted via the Avon and Somerset Police website. The website also has a reporting page for non-emergency crimes and its often easier to report this way rather than calling 101.

We also host regular beat surgeries at the brilliant Made for Ever Community Centre, dates are printed in the magazine and we can often be found in Kings Chase Shopping Centre.

I wanted to mention that amongst our other duties the team are spending a lot of time in schools dealing with issues around social media. Young people sending upsetting, abusive, posts and texts to others.

It is not ok to do this. It is bullying and we deal with it. The offence is Malicious Communication. Sending messages of this type can result in a criminal record which could affect a young person's future. I would urge all parents or carers of young people to be aware of what their child is looking at and doing online and please, encourage your child to be kind online. This advice goes for adults to.
