## Background

The adult social care sector is experiencing a significant workforce shortage. An **estimated 150,000+ additional staff are needed** to meet growing demand due to an ageing population and increasing complexity of care needs. Over 60% of providers report challenges in recruiting and retaining staff.

## Roles and Pay

There are **over 30 job roles** across residential care, domiciliary care, and community support. Many roles offer progression through Level 2 to Level 5 qualifications, with opportunities for specialisation and leadership.

- **Nursery Assistant:** £15,000 – £18,000
- **Care Assistant / Support Worker:** £18,000 – £22,000
- **Senior Care Worker:** £22,000 – £26,000
- **Team Leader / Supervisor:** £25,000 – £30,000

- **Registered Manager:** £35,000 – £50,000+
- **Social Worker:** £32,000 – £45,000
- **Occupational Therapist:** £35,000 – £50,000
- **Live-in Carer (Self-employed):** £25,000–£40,000

## Diversity and Inclusion

Diversity and inclusion are vital for delivering person-centered care. The sector encourages a workforce that reflects the communities it serves, including more male carers and individuals from varied cultural backgrounds.

## DBS Checks

**All roles in adult social care require a DBS check**, typically an Enhanced DBS check with barred lists for roles involving vulnerable adults. Employers usually support applicants through the process.

Those setting up their own care service must register with the Care Quality Commission (CQC) in England or the relevant regulatory body in Wales, Scotland, or Northern Ireland.

### DBS checks for adult social care workers – GOV.UK:

## Diversity and Inclusion

Diversity and inclusion are vital for delivering person-centered care. The sector encourages a workforce that reflects the communities it serves, including more male carers and individuals from varied cultural backgrounds.

## DBS Checks

**All roles in adult social care require a DBS check**, typically an Enhanced DBS check with barred lists for roles involving vulnerable adults. Employers usually support applicants through the process.

Those setting up their own care service must register with the Care Quality Commission (CQC) in England or the relevant regulatory body in Wales, Scotland, or Northern Ireland.
